

Our Flagship Programs

Our Chaplain takes the lead role in facilitating our flagship programs contributing to student wellbeing: Highway Heroes and Peacemakers. These two programs have allowed our students to build and maintain healthy relationships.

Highway Heroes is a social and emotional learning program which gives students the resources they need to develop a variety of relationship skills such as resilience, mood management, taming teasing, wisdom and developing grit. This is done in the context of life being a journey, a Learning Highway, and navigating speed bumps and hazards. Students are provided with tools designed to get them back to being a Highway Hero. These are students who are successful at travelling smoothly; who can make and keep friends, join in, learn to their potential, make and achieve goals, keep calm and do things which make them happy and successful.

Peacemakers is a conflict resolution program which allows students to develop the ability to speak out their needs and feelings while being heard and responded to in a safe and responsive manner. Removing the fear of confrontation and resolving issues without the need for attack or escape. Peacemakers allows a common platform for all students to have resolution which gives them their own power of management
